COMPONENT: TRANSPORTATION

SUBJECT: GENERAL TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS

PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVE: Each agency must assist as many families as possible who need transportation in order for their children to attend the program in obtaining that transportation.

POLICY AND PROCEDURE:

We will assist as many families as possible who need transportation in order for their children to attend the Head Start Program. Transportation services may not be provided to all students. Reasonable assistance will be made to arrange transportation to and from Head Start activities. Transportation will be provided for children attending Field Trips and medical/dental trips.

Options for transporting children to and from the center include:

- Parent/Guardian or other authorized adult
- Day Care centers that provide transportation for before and after hours care.
- Public transportation when available
- Other parent/guardian initiated arrangements

Parents/Guardians will be responsible for selecting the option best suited to fit their needs. The program will not be responsible for paying the cost of transporting children nor liable for the safety of children through any of these options.
